**Veterinary inspection**

Veterinary inspection is on Saturday 27.4. 8:30 am to 9:30 pm and on Sunday 28.4. 8:30 am to 9:30 pm.

All horses participating in the show are obliged to undergo veterinary inspection. Horses who do not have the appropriate veterinary certificate for movement for the purpose of sporting events with all prescribed particulars valid for 2019 will not be admitted to the premises!

Each horse owner or presenter shall provide the show management / veterinarian with appropriate documents for the transport of the horse in accordance with veterinary requirements.

Horses must be healthy and have all proper vaccinations according to the valid scheme and examination necessary for the transport of horses and participation in competitions (according to the veterinary conditions of the Czech Republic).

Horse owners or presenters guarantee that there is no contagious disease in the stable where the horses come from.

According to the Rules, the referee or showmanagement has the right to exclude horses in races for abuse or excessive cruel treatment.

**OTHER CONDITIONS:**

The organizer and its organizing team reserve the right to change these PROPOSITIONS, including the right to change the venue or cancel the event for particularly serious reasons, while refunding the fees already paid.

Competitors, horse owners, accompanying team members and other persons, including visitors, are obliged to follow the instructions of the organizers and observe the general safety rules. The course of the event is governed by the Silverstone Western Cup rules, which are publicly accessible at [www.silverstone-westerncup.com](http://www.silverstone-westerncup.com) and further approved by the Animal Protection Code.

There is no contractual relationship between the organizers on the one hand and visitors, participants and horse owners on the other.

Liability for damage to brought or deferred things is the relationship between the operator of the premises and the injured person, provided that the conditions of the relevant provisions of the Civil Code are met.

Stabling (stowage) of the horse in the area is possible only by agreement with the person in charge of these matters. The area is not guarded. Places intended for storing things such as saddles must be explicitly marked. The operator of the premises reserves the right to show vehicles that will be used for overnight stays. Dogs must be on a leash throughout the event.

Horse owners, demonstrators, accompanying persons and other participants relieve the organizer of any liability for damage to health or for the loss, theft or damage of things (including animals) and financial damage, except where this is not permitted by generally binding legal regulations.

Responsibility for damage caused by animals or other things lies with the person responsible for the thing. Liability for damage caused by persons lies with the person who caused the damage or his / her legal representative.

We recommend horse owners to take out their own liability insurance. Show management is entitled to impose instructions, eventually on the visitors, attendees and accompanying persons. Expel persons who, by their behavior, disrupt the course of the action and endanger the safety of persons or animals; the referee has the same authority.

**It is not allowed to lunge horses in the hall.**
